

## Outcome analysis for Pupil Premium Students

(RAISEOnline November 2016)

There were 7 Pupil Premium (PP) students in this cohort of 202. There were no CLA in this cohort. Average progress nationally for all students is 0.

Raiseonline shows that PP students attained better than the national average for all students as well as the national average for disadvantaged students in 2016. The gap suggests that on average, PP students attained approximately half a grade higher in English and Maths than national non-disadvantaged students.

Given our small numbers and the large confidence intervals, meaningful comments on PP progress, be that Progress 8, Progress in English or Progress in Maths valid statistical statements cannot be made.
