General Uniform (from September 2026)

Choice of	Black School Blazer and/or Red V Neck Pullover	Badge must be sewn on blazer pocket Not cardigan or round neck
Choice of	White open neck blouse with no tie Or White button up shirt with tie	Must be official school tie
Choice of	Black Pinstripe Kilt with School Emblem Or Black Polyester/Viscose Trousers Or School tailored shorts with the school badge	Kilt must be 22in in length and brought from one of our uniform suppliers. The kilt must not be altered and must be approaching the knee. Suppliers have discretion to supply a shorter length if the kilt fits on the knee. Must be straight leg, regulation school trousers, as found at our uniform suppliers and in the uniform aisles of other shops. School tailored shorts can be bought from one of our uniform suppliers.
Choice of	Socks Or Tights	Ankle length, black or white Neutral or plain black. Leggings are not permitted. Socks must not be worn over tights
Shoes	Plain black leather/leather effect shoe	Flat heel. Canvas shoes or boots are NOT permitted.
Optional	A white base layer may be worn in winter	

Jewellery:

A small stud in each ear is permitted. No other decorative jewellery will be permitted.

Make up/Nail Varnish:

Light makeup may be worn, but should be subtle and not obvious.

Coloured nail varnish is not permitted and no false nails or gel of any sort may be worn. False eye lashes are also not permitted.

Hair Colour and Style:

The school has very high standards for the uniform and appearance of all students. As part of this, we have clear expectations on the style of hair that is deemed appropriate for the school environment as set out below.

Hair must be a natural colour. A wide range of hairstyles is permitted such as braids, locs, twists and cornrows. Headscarves and head coverings are permitted for religious and medical reasons only.

Students are expected to have:

- Moderate hairstyles, avoiding extremes that are not the norm within our society



- Hair of a natural colour or highlighting that is seen as the norm within our society
Hair ornaments are not permitted, though neat and smart braiding is acceptable and any religious requirements with regard to hairstyle will be accepted after consultation with the Pastoral Team.

Winter Wear:

During the winter, A WHITE undershirt or base layer may be worn under the normal school shirt or blouse, but the normal jumper or blazer must be worn over the top. Trainers or boots may be worn to school but these need to be changed into normal school shoes on arrival. Outdoor coats may be worn to school and outside during break and lunchtime. Outdoor coats should be plain in either black, dark navy, red or grey. One small logo is permitted. No other form of outdoor garment is permitted. Hoodies are not permitted at any time in school.
