Public Examinations results 2023

Our examination results were, once again, outstanding with 60% A* and A at A level and 47% grades 9 and 8 at GCSE with 95% of candidates achieving 5 or more GCSEs graded 9–4 grades including English and Mathematics. Further information about the results can be found below.

75% of Year 11 students are pursuing courses in our Sixth Form. 89% of the Sixth Form went on to university, 3 went on to degree apprenticeships, 1 went on into employment and 13 students have deferred their place, or are applying to begin their University education in 2024.

Summary of results at A level and GCSE, summer 2023

Our students again secured outstanding A level results this year. 82% of all grades were awarded A*- B, with 25% of all entries being awarded an A* and 34% an A grade. 99% of all entries secured a pass grade.

Our GCSE results were equally impressive with 24% of all grades awarded at a grade 9 with a further 23% of all grades secured at a grade 8. 67% of all grades achieved were 9-7 which is roughly equivalent to the old A* and A grades or higher.

95% of our students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at standard pass or above including English and Maths.
