### Public Examinations results 2022

Our examination results were, once again, outstanding with 77% A\*A at A level and 62% grades 9 and 8 at GCSE with 95% of candidates achieving 5 or more GCSEs graded 9–4 grades (A\*-C) including English and Mathematics. Further information about the results can be found below.

79% of Year 11 students are pursuing courses in our Sixth Form. 82% of the Sixth Form went on to university and 17% of the students have deferred their place, or are applying to begin their University education in 2023.

### Summary of results at A level and GCSE, summer 2022

Our students again secured outstanding A level results this year. 92% of all grades were awarded A\* - B, with 45% of all entries being awarded an A\* and 32% an A grade. 100% of all entries secured a pass grade.

Our GCSE results were equally impressive with 40.3% of all grades awarded at a grade 9 with a further 21.3% of all grades secured at a grade 8. 76% of all grades achieved were 9-7 which is roughly equivalent to the old A\*A grades or higher.

95% of our students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at standard pass or above including English and Maths.
