Public Examinations results 2025

Our examination results were, once again, outstanding with 66.3% A* and A at A level and 53% grades 9 and 8 at GCSE with 94% of candidates achieving 5 or more GCSEs graded 9–4 grades including English and Mathematics. Further information about the results can be found below.

77% of Year 11 students are pursuing courses in our Sixth Form. 90% of the Sixth Form went on to university, 4 went on to conservatoire, 2 went on into employment and 27 students have deferred their place, or are applying to begin their University education in 2025.

Summary of results at A level and GCSE, summer 2025

Our students again secured outstanding A level results this year. 89.1% of all grades were awarded A* - B, with 30.9% of all entries being awarded an A* and 35.4% an A grade.

Our GCSE results were equally impressive with 29.2% of all grades awarded at a grade 9 with a further 23.9% of all grades secured at a grade 8. 72.5% of all grades achieved were 9-7 which is roughly equivalent to the old A* and A grades or higher.

94% of our students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at standard pass or above including English and Maths.
